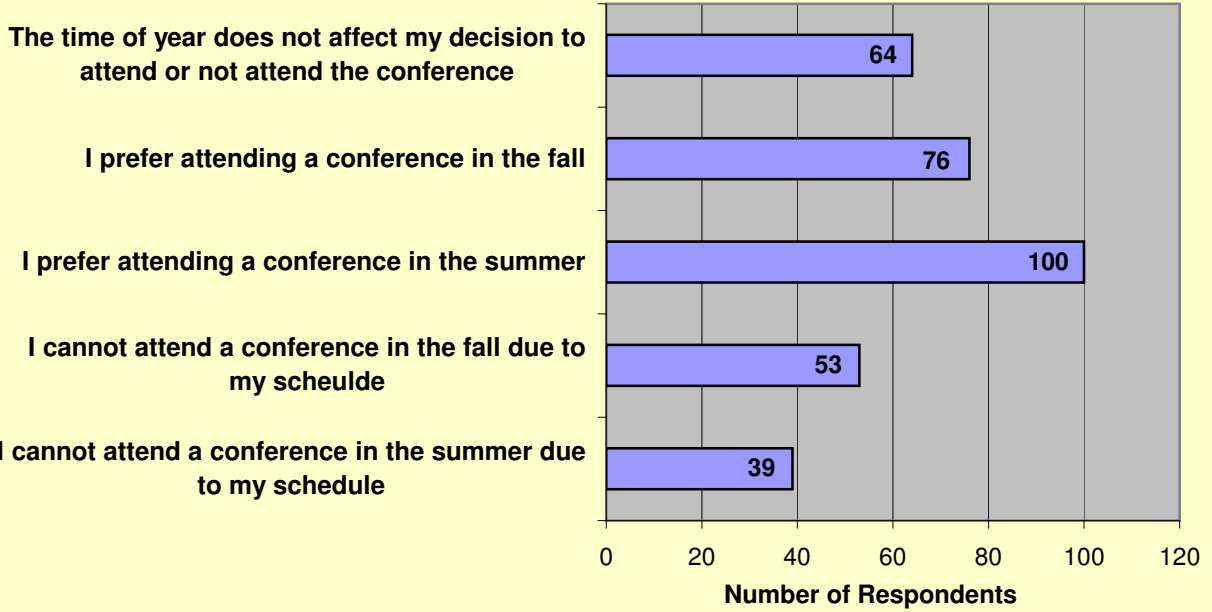


## Which statements reflect your views about conference attendance?
